Coming from South of Cleveland (Courtyard by Marriott, Independence):

Take I-77 N. Take the Pershing Ave exit—exit #160. At the top of the ramp, turn right onto Pershing. Proceed through the intersection, heading East past two traffic signals (about 0.1 miles). The second signal will be Broadway. The Bohemian National Hall is located on the corner of Pershing and Broadway. Continue past Broadway to the parking lot at the rear of the building, off Pershing.

Coming from West of Cleveland:

Take I-90 E. It becomes I-490 E, as you enter Cleveland. Take the OH 14/Broadway Ave exit—exit #2A. At the top of the ramp, turn right onto Broadway Ave. The Bohemian National Hall is located 0.5 miles down Broadway on the left-hand side of the road at the corner of Pershing and Broadway. Turn left onto Pershing and enter the parking lot at the rear or the building, off Pershing.

Coming from East of Cleveland:

Take I-90 W. As you approach Cleveland, merge onto I-77 S/OH-21 S via exit #172A toward AKRON (0.7 miles). Take exit #162A toward Woodland Ave/Broadway/E 30th St (0.1 mile). Turn right onto E 30th St (0.1 mile). Turn left onto Broadway Ave/Pittsburgh Ave/OH-14. The Bohemian National Hall is located 1.4 miles down Broadway on the left-hand side of the road at the corner of Pershing and Broadway. If you turn left onto Pershing, you will find parking in rear of the building, off Pershing.

Coming from Southwest of Cleveland (Courtyard, Middleburgh Hts./Airport):

Take I-71 N. Merge onto I-490 E via exit 247A toward I-77. Follow above directions Coming from West of Cleveland.

Preliminary Round: Pure Balboa—This round will take place during the second band break on Friday night. It will be BALBOA only. Close body contact between partners must be maintained at all times (couples' torsos must maintain contact the entire round. This means: no crossovers, no breakaway turns, no lollies, no rock-steps/resets, etc.)

Warm-up All Skate—This round will start with a non-judged all skate. There may be 2 heats depending on the space available and the number of couples in the competition.

HEATS — The main portion of this round will be danced in heats. There will be 8 heats consisting of 5 couples each. If the maximum number of couples is less than 40, then there will be fewer couples in each of the 6 heats and/or there will be less than 6 heats.

Final All Skate — When all of the heats are complete, ALL of the couples will dance to another song. This will be judged. If the judges feel it necessary, ALL of the couples will dance again to an additional song. This will also be judged.

The finalists will be announced before midnight on Friday night. Approximately 10 couples will be brought back for the final round. The number of couples brought back will be determined by the natural break in scores.

Please note that the couples are being judged against ALL of the other couples in the contest, not just one particular heat. Therefore the couples brought back for the final round will be the best out of the entire group. There is no minimum number of couples to be brought back from each heat. Judges will be looking for timing, teamwork, finesse, footwork and musicality.

Final round: Swing (Bal-Swing) - This round will take place during the second band break on Saturday night. Anything goes in this round. There are NO restrictions. However, emphasis will be placed on finesse, footwork, and musicality. Therefore, if a dip, trick, or aerial does not fit the music, it may not be beneficial to your final score.

- 1st ALL SKATE— All of the couples will dance to a 2 minute song.
- **SPOTLIGHT** Each couple will then get a 1.5 minute solo dance.
- 2nd ALL SKATE— When all of the heats are complete, ALL of the couples
 will dance to another song. This will be judged. If the judges feel it necessary, ALL of the couples will dance again to an additional song. This will
 also be judged.

Once again, judges will be looking for timing, teamwork, finesse, footwork and musicality.
